At age seven, Dianne invited Jesus Christ into her heart as Savior and Lord. Being so young, she later had doubts until settling the fact forever, claiming the promise of Romans 10:13, that "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

A lifelong resident of Johnson City, Tennessee, she married her high-school sweetheart, James Barker—her best friend and encourager. They have two children (now grown) and served for several years as Marriage Enrichment leaders for Holston Baptist Association. Dianne began writing for the Johnson City *Press-Chronicle* while pursuing a Bachelor's Degree in English at East Tennessee State University. After graduating, she accepted a full-time position at the newspaper, earning much acclaim as a news and feature writer. Her weekly column "Of Cabbages and Kings" was widely read.

An assignment to cover Billy Graham's historic Knoxville crusade (which claimed national headlines when President Richard Nixon attended) led to writing her first book at age 24, *Billy Graham in Big Orange Country*.

After leaving the newspaper to be a stay-at-home mom, she co-authored several books, including *Twice Pardoned* with Harold Morris, which quickly rose to number one on the national Christian best-sellers list. She also wrote *Living Proof* with Clebe McClary and *A Journey of Victory* with Walter St. Clair.

She has written for numerous Christian publications, including *Marriage Partnership*, *Christian Communicator*, and *HomeLife*. She is a contributing author to *The One Year Life Verse Devotional* (Tyndale).

Her soul desire is to walk daily in wholehearted devotion, declaring God's praise through the spoken and written word.
